Saw only 1 underwing moth tonight. Saw one Lunate Zale at baited tree. Very few insects/moths on UV-lighted sheet. On second pass the tree S of the alt. outhouse had 24 moths; the tree in the SE corner from the alt. outhouse had 22 moths; the tree closest to the alt. outhouse had 19 moths. On third pass those same three trees had 15, 16, and 9 moths respectively.

Many, many acorns and nuts on the ground, making approaches to trees more difficult.
