

## Moth Survey Results

**Date:** March 19, 2004

**Location:** Wickiup Hill Natural Area

**Number of trees baited:** 8

**Weather:** 18:15, 56°, lt –mod. strong S winds, clear

19:24, 52°, lt. – moderate S winds, cloudy

### Circuits and Moths per Tree

18:55 – 19:15 .37

### Comments

1. No moon.
2. Moderate moth activity at lights, N end of bldg.
3. Left site at 8:05 p.m.

### Captures and Time

1. Small moth at light, N end of building, env. 1 – 18:46
2. Medium mottled moth on bait, env. 2 – 19:09
3. Medium dark moth at front door of bldg, env. 3 – 19:27
4. Medium light moth on baited tree, env. 4 – 19:39
5. Medium-small dark moth on cement, N end of bldg, env. 5 – 19:57

Heard some spring peepers from wet areas west of trail. Caught a beetle for Doug Veal on baited tree 20 yards SSE of outhouse; this beetle, per Doug, is unrecorded from Iowa. Saw one other smaller beetle on same tree; it got away. Saw about a half dozen small moths attracted to lights at north end of building, plus one very interesting medium moth that eluded me – I needed the net and didn't have it.
