1. Thick crescent moon mostly covered by clouds.
2. Bait out at 6:47. With Jim Durbin.
3. Set up N of sandy rise. Left site at 9:15 p.m.

10. Medium light brown moth at front door, env. 60 – 20:34
11. Medium dark moth at N wall of bldg, env. 61 – 20:41
12. Medium small moth at N wall, env. 62 – 20:45
13. Medium moth at sheet, env. 63 – 20:52
14. Medium moth at sheet, env. 64 – 20:58
15. Medium moth at sheet, env. 65 – 21:02
16. Medium moth at sheet, env. 66 – 21:10

Heard *many* frogs – at times the sound was near deafening. Saw several leopard frogs, plus up to 6 at a time at the sheet. Most were about 1” long with an “X” on their backs. One of the little guys had black stripes running down the length of its body.

I set up my two Coleman lanterns, each with 1 UV and 1 fluorescent bulb. Jim also had two light sources using the same lighting as I had. Caught a beetle for Doug Veal.
