1. 1st quarter moon hidden by clouds
2. Lights on at 6:45. Lights off at 8:25.
3. Set up large blacklight fixture by deck.
4. Sunset 6:15 p.m.

2. Medium small dark moth at sugar bait, env. B – 19:05
3. Medium small dark moth at sugar bait, env. C – 19:08
4. Smallish light moth at sugar bait, env. D – 19:48
5. Medium dark moth at sugar bait, env. E – 19:51
6. Small moth at sugar bait, env. F – 19:56; had wings folded above body
7. Medium dark moth at sugar bait, env. G – 19:58
8. Medium small dark moth at sugar bait, env. H – 19:58 [sic]

Saw no underwings, scape moths, or zales tonight. One 2.5-inch long walking stick near front door of building; brown body, green legs. Caught medium light beetle for Doug at 7:29 by front door.
