

Moth Survey Results

Date: August 10, 2003

Location: Squaw Creek Park

Number of trees baited: 12

Weather: 20:35, 76°, 0-5 mph NW wind, cloudy

21:50, 74°, 0-4 wind, mostly cloudy

Circuits and Moths per Tree*

20:50 – 21:15 .17 [2 moths]

21:20 – 21:47 .42 [5 moths]

22:00 – 22:20 .00 [0 moths]

Comments

1. Near full moon, 60% humidity
2. No light; bait out at 8:25. Left site at 22:25.
3. Distant lightning in far NNW
4. Moth mostly hidden by clouds

Captures and Time

1. Medium dark moth at baited tree 21:02, env. 1 [on tree in corner by woods ENE of MV light]
2. Medium large underwing moth at baited tree 21:35, env. A [on tree by meadow at NE – “six moth tree”]

Missed a medium-large underwing at 9:47 on newly-baited tree to south of alternative parking lot.
