

Moth Survey Results

Date: Oct. 3, 2003

Location: Squaw Creek Park

Number of trees baited: 15→13

Weather: 19:30, 59°, light to sometimes mod winds.

20:00, 56°, light wind, mostly cloudy.

20:40, 53°, 0-1 mph wind, thinning clouds

Circuits and Moths per Tree*

19:20 – 19:54 1.7 [26 moths]

20:05 – 20:36 0.6 [8 moths]

20:45 – 21:13 0.5 [6 moths]

Comments

1. Original site; bait out at 6:55. **No light used.**
2. 1st quarter moon mostly hidden by clouds.
3. Both bathroom/MV streetlight on.
4. Humidity 40%.

Captures and Time

1. Medium small light moth at baited tree 19:36, env. 82.
2. Medium small light moth at baited tree 19:36, [sic] env. 83.
3. Medium dark moth at baited tree 19:47, env. 84.
4. Medium dark moth at baited tree 20:57, env. 85.

Note: Prior to tonight, we had several nights where temperatures fell into the mid-twenties. Saw no underwings.

Saw about three dozen ladybugs on one of the baited trees.
