At lights out, about 80 moths were on the sheet, including several dozen scabras. Also on the sheet: Xanthotype sospeta, fresh Luna at 9:08, costalis, renigera, orange wing, scopula limboundata.

Had numerous battery problems: the first large battery (the oldest) didn't have enough power to do anything but make the two bulbs flicker; the second large battery lasted just 33 minutes, at which time I disconnected the fluorescent tube to make the next battery last longer; the third battery lasted one hour 18 minutes powering just the UV bulb; and the small battery couldn't even power the one UV bulb. So I gave up around 10:15 p.m.
